

## WELCOME TO COTTENHAM COMMUNITY CENTRE PLEASE HELP KEEP THIS BUILDING COVID-19 SECURE

- 1. You must not enter if you or anyone in your household has any COVID-19 symptoms.
- 2. Wearing of a face covering is REQUIRED (Government winter PLAN B) in all of our hired spaces and when moving about the Community Centre. Face coverings may be removed during exercise, during singing (as part of a choir or similar) and while eating or drinking for example once you are sat down at your table in the Coffee Shop. Age, health or disability reasons for exemption are recognised.
- 3. NHS COVID-19 App users may scan (check-in) as they enter. Alternatively, you may supply your name and a contact number to our Coffee Shop staff or to the organiser of your activity. Names and contact numbers will be passed to NHS Test and Trace should they request it.
- **4. Maintain social distancing as far as possible**. Follow all signage in-relation to distancing and direction of movement through the premises. Tables in the Coffee Shop are arranged to enable safe distancing.
- **5.** Use the hand sanitiser provided on entering the premises. Clean your hands often.
- **6. Avoid touching your face, nose, or eyes.** Clean your hands if you do.
- **7. "Catch it, Bin it, Kill it".** Tissues should be disposed of into one of the waste bins provided. Then wash your hands.
- 8. If taking part in an organised activity, check the organisers have cleaned touchpoints (eg. door handles & switches/controls) and surfaces before your arrival. Help to keep these areas clean. CCC cannot clean all touchpoints and surfaces between each hire. Organisers will also take responsibility to keep their activity space well ventilated.
- **9.** Respect others; take turns to use confined spaces such as corridors. Standing or sitting next to someone is lower risk than opposite them. Briefly passing another person in a confined space is considered low risk.
