Your data is important to us and we have to ask you for permission to help us manage our contact with volunteers. We will not divulge your email address to others unless you allow us to. Please note, if you wish to sign up to the other Warm Hub in the village (at the **Village Hall** on Lambs Lane, that currently operates on Monday mornings) you will need to contact clerk@cottenhampc.org.uk , in the first instance.

Volunteers are a key part of our activities at the Community Centre. You can support the Community Centre by paying to become a member, but you do **not** have to do this, but still offer practical support or to be a volunteer <https://www.cottenhamcc.org/membership> We usually have vacancies for Trustees!

Our preferred method of contact for the Warm Hub is likely to be **email**, and we will keep a list of names and email addresses for this purpose, together with a note of likely skills.

There may be times when we need to contact you on the **phone**; it is helpful to have an immediate response.

We are considering the use of **WhatsApp**, to raise urgent issues or ask for help within a group simultaneously. Any message sent to the WhatsApp group will go to everybody in the group for those who have it and others in the group will see your phone number.
